GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. To qualify for any versatility title, dogs must have one of the following certificates:
 - a. OFA Hips evaluated at Fair or better.
 - b. PENN Hip evaluated at equal to or tighter than the tightest 50% of the current breed statistics.
 - c. Proof of sterilization on a veterinarian's letterhead.
2. All owners of record must be in good standing with the American Kennel Club
3. At least one owner of record must be a member in good standing with the German Wirehaired Pointer Club of America
4. Dogs living at the time of the introduction of this system are eligible for recognition.

GENERAL SCORING REQUIRMENTS

1. Points in any one area are not cumulative. eg. A Utility Dog title entitles the dog to 6 points, the CDX and CD are not added for an additional 6 points.

2. In the agility area, preferred and non-preferred points for a given level may not be added. e.g. a dog with a Novice Agility title gets 2 points, that dog may not receive an additional one point for a Novice Agility Preferred title. The dog with the Novice Agility title can however receive a total of 3 points if it finishes an Open Agility Preferred title.
3. In the obedience/rally area, obedience and rally points for a given level may not be added. e.g. a dog with a companion dog title gets 2 points, that dog may not receive an additional 2 points for rally novice. The dog with the companion dog title can however receive a total of 3 points if it finishes a rally advanced title.
4. In order to qualify for any versatile title, the maximum points in one area must be held. e.g. A dog holding a JH and a water test pass must hold the maximum points in another area such as conformation or obedience to qualify for the title of Versatile, "V".

TITLE SCORING REQUIREMENTS

Requirements for award of the title Versatile "V"

1. Twelve (12) versatile points minimum
2. The twelve points must be obtained from at least three areas
3. A minimum of JH and a water test must be held.

Requirements for award of the title Versatile Excellent "VX"

1. Eighteen (18) points minimum
2. The eighteen points must be obtained from at least three areas.
3. A minimum of 6 points from the Field Area must be held

Requirements for award of the title Versatile Superior "VS"

1. Twenty four (24) points minimum
2. The 24 points must be obtained from at least four areas
3. A minimum of 10 points from the Field Area must be held
